International Summer School "Natural Hazards"

Ljubljana, 21st May–10th June, 2017

The University of Ljubljana (SI), the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences from Vienna (A), the University of Brescia (I), and the company Piktorama d.o.o. (SI) are organising two international interdisciplinary summer schools, both in Ljubljana, Slovenia, in the framework of Erasmus+ 2015 project KA2-HE-14/15. The first summer school *Environmental Protection* took place in 2016, while the second summer school *Natural Disasters* will take place in 2017.

The *Natural Disasters* summer school will be held between **May 21 and June 10, 2017**. This is going to be a combination of blended learning supported by e-classroom (first week) and face-to-face learning (second and third weeks). The main topics to be covered are: *flood-related natural disasters, droughts, landslides, and earthquakes*. The lectures and workshops will be run by an international team of lecturers from the three involved universities as well as some other distinguished guests. The students will be actively involved in the work through discussions, round tables, participation at the 4th World Landslide Forum, preparations of presentations, and the final exam. Successful participation will be rewarded by **5 ECTS**.

The first 20 accepted applicants from the University of Ljubljana, the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences from Vienna, and the University of Brescia will obtain a full scholarship for attending the summer school. The call is open also to other students in EU, but the total number of participants is limited to 40. The registration fee is 900 EUR and it includes tuition, study materials, distance learning, participation fee for the 4th World Landslide Forum, an organized excursion, accommodation, meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner), and administrative and IT support. **The call is open for PhD students and Masters students** interested to pursue PhD degree. The students who would like to attend the summer school without being present in Ljubljana will take part in the first week of blended learning and e-classroom activities as other participants, while later they could attend lectures and workshops online. In this case, the registration fee is 300 EUR and the participants will obtain a confirmation letter of attendance, but no ECTS.
