For the seventh consecutive year, the **Young Surveyor's Prize** is inviting the students of **topography, GIS, geodesy, mapping and related studies** to submit their unique and innovative ideas in their field of expertise. The contest is organised by The Council of European Geodetic Surveyors (CLGE) in partnership with the European GNSS Agency (GSA) which is sponsoring a special prize for ideas based on **Galileo, EGNOS and Copernicus**.

- + 35 years old or younger
- + All European countries
- + Individual and team submissions allowed
