## About the Program

The International Summer School (ISS) program at the University of Seoul (UOS) was first established in 2000, and it has provided international students with a great opportunity to learn about Korean culture and tradition. Reorganized in 2005, the ISS has been receiving an increased amount of funds from the Seoul Metropolitan Government and offers various incentives to participants coming from UOS partner universities and many other prestigious universities all over the world.

## Specialties of the Program

### ★ UOS Buddy Program!

UOS offers a buddy program for international students. The buddies are UOS Korean students who help international students adjust to life in Korea. The UOS buddies offer a welcome pick-up service at Incheon International Airport, live with the international students at the dorm, and participate in most of the programs offered by the ISS with all of the international students.

### ★ Mingling with Friends from All over the World!

In 2015, you can build a global network by making many friends from Australia, Austria, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Israel, Kazakhstan, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Taiwan, Thailand, UK, USA, and more.

### ★ Chance to Explore Jeju Island in Korea!

A 4-day field trip to Jeju Island in Korea will give you a better understanding about Korea.

### ★ Various Field Trips and Cultural Activities

To learn about Korea's past, present and future, you can experience various kinds of activities while visiting meaningful spots in Korea such as Changdeok Palace (UNESCO World Heritage), Bukchon's Hanok Village, and the JSA (Joint Security Area). Activities like learning Taekwondo (Korean martial arts), making Korean traditional masks, or watching a NANTA Show will create unforgettable memories as well.

## Admission Requirements

- \* UOS International Summer School accepts ONLY exchange students from partner universities.
- \* Undergraduates or Postgraduates from UOS partner universities are eligible for the program.

### ★ Application Process

**Step 1** UOS partner universities' International Offices are asked to nominate their students via email to [uossummer@uos.ac.kr](mailto:uossummer@uos.ac.kr) from **February 1 to April 30, 2015**.

**Step 2** Each of the applicants are required to complete **the on-line application** (at <http://iice.uos.ac.kr> → For International Students → Studying in UOS → International Summer School → Eligibility & Application) **from March 1 to April 30, 2015**.

**Step 3** UOS issues the admission letter and invoice, which will be emailed to each applicant and to his/her home university's International Office.
